



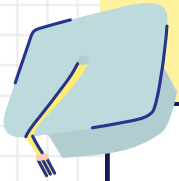

School Uniform and Appearance

We kindly request that parents assist us in ensuring that learners adhere to the school's uniform and appearance policy.

Jewellery

- Learners may wear small gold, silver, black sleepers or studs.
- Only one earring per ear is permitted.
- Earrings must be worn on the ear lobe and must be a matching pair.
- Visible piercings or jewellery worn in other parts of the body, including the nose, eyebrows, or tongue, are not permitted.

Make-Up

- No make-up may be worn to school.
- This includes lip liner and eyelash extensions.

Hair

- Hair may not hang in the learner's face.
- Long hair must be clipped back.
- Fringes may not extend below the eyebrows.
- Black, red, or green hair bands may be worn to keep hair neat and out of the face.

Name Badges

- Learner name badges form part of the official school uniform.
- Lost badges must be replaced at a cost of R65 through the Finance Office.
- Damaged or broken badges must also be replaced at a cost of R65.
- Learners not wearing a badge will receive demerits.

Your support in maintaining these standards is greatly appreciated.

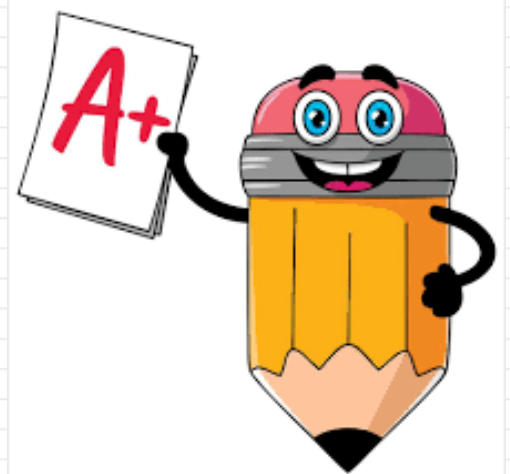
Report Collection
