MID-YEAR EXAMINATIONS

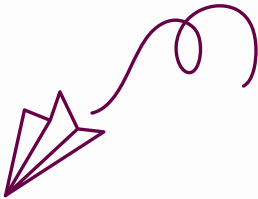
Congratulations to all our learners on successfully completing the mid-year examinations. We acknowledge the hard work, dedication and perseverance demonstrated during this demanding assessment period.

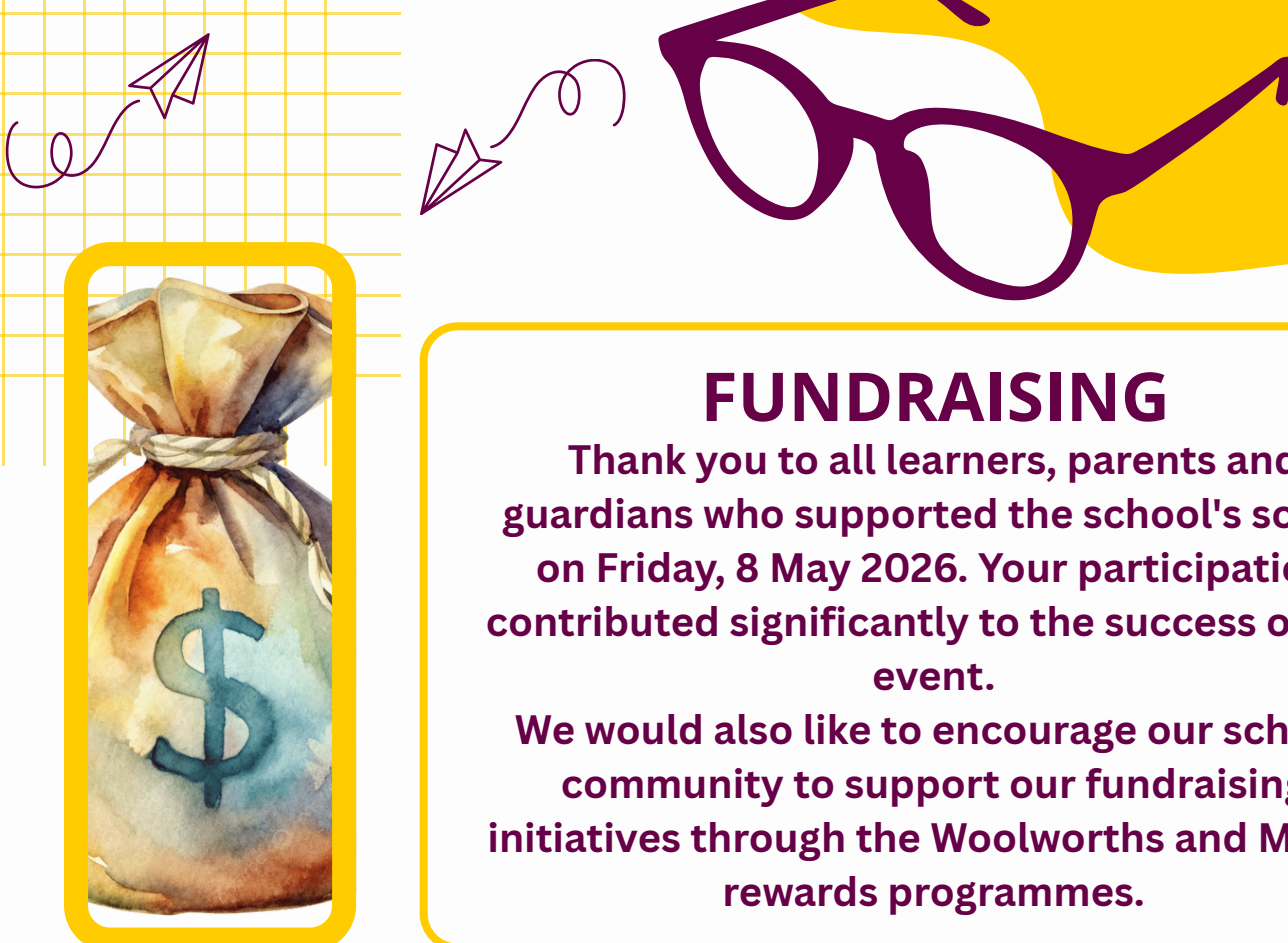
LEARNER ATTENDANCE

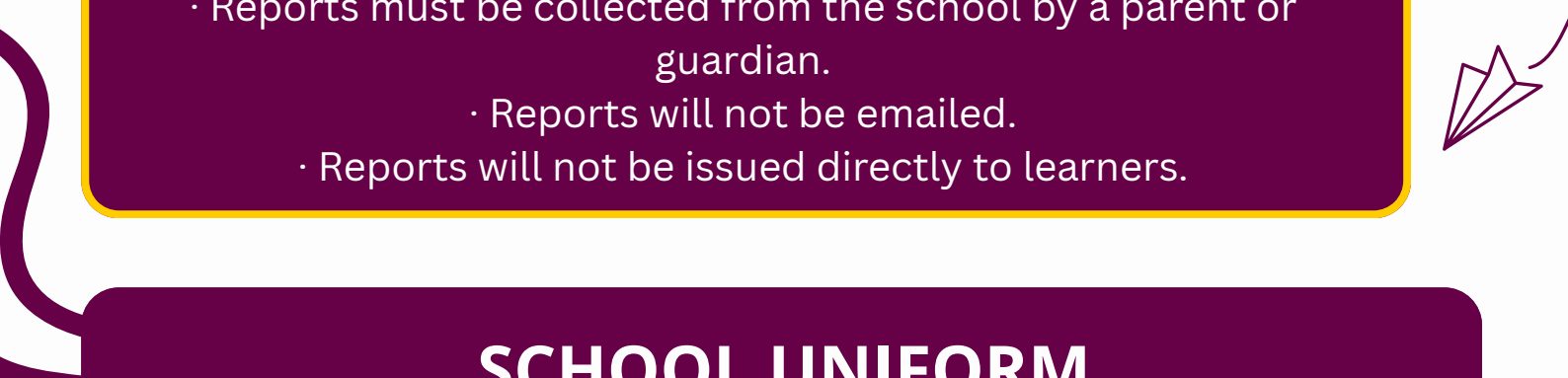
To participate, download the Makro mCard App on your mobile phone and register. Once linked to the Greenside High School group, your purchases will automatically contribute towards our fundraising efforts.



REPORT COLLECTION

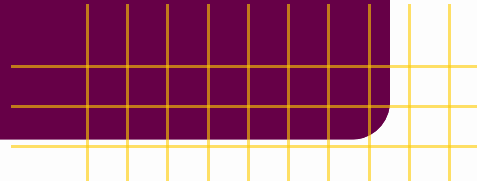
Parents and guardians will be informed via SMS and the Grade WhatsApp groups when reports are available for collection.

Please note:

- Reports must be collected from the school by a parent or guardian.
 - Reports will not be emailed.
 - Reports will not be issued directly to learners.
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SCHOOL UNIFORM

We remind all learners and parents of the school's uniform and appearance requirements:

- Learners may wear small gold, silver or black sleepers or studs. Only one earring per ear is permitted and must be worn on the earlobe. A matching pair must be worn.
 - Visible piercings and jewellery worn in any other part of the body, including the nose, eyebrows and tongue, are not permitted.
 - No make-up may be worn to school. This includes lip liner and eyelash extensions.
 - Hair must be kept out of the face. Long hair hanging in the face must be clipped back. Fringes may not extend below the eyebrows.
 - Learners may wear a black, red or green hair band to keep hair away from the face.
 - Learner badges form part of the official school uniform. Lost, damaged or broken badges must be replaced through the Finance Office at a cost of R65.
 - Learners who do not wear a name badge will receive demerits.
- We thank parents and guardians for supporting the school in maintaining these standards.
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SCHOOL THRIFT SHOP

Parents and learners are encouraged to make use of the school's Thrift Shop, conveniently situated on the school premises.

- Learners who have outgrown their uniforms are encouraged to donate these items to the Thrift Shop.
- Learners requiring uniform items are encouraged to visit the shop and purchase any missing items.
- School uniform repairs are also undertaken at a reasonable cost.
- The Thrift Shop is open every Tuesday and Thursday afternoon immediately after school for 45 minutes.
